

# VALERIE BLOOM



Valerie Bloom was born in Jamaica and came to England in 1979. She is the author of numerous poetry collections for children and adults, as well as picture books and novels for young readers. Her poems in English and in Jamaican Patois have appeared in over 250 anthologies.

Valerie has performed her poetry all over the world, and works tirelessly in schools, giving performances and workshops. Her many television and radio appearances include presenting poetry programmes on BBC Radio 3, Radio 4 and the CBeebies TV and radio channels.

Valerie's awards include the Voice Community Award for Literature, the Nestlé Smarties Prize (Bronze Award), three CLPE poetry awards, an Honorary Masters Degree from her alma mater the University of Kent at Canterbury, and an MBE for services to poetry.
